HPRP is Idaho's legislatively-authorized route for helping impaired medical licensees and has **graduated 61 people since 2014**. The program's high success rate is attributable to ongoing peer support, worksite and chemical monitoring, and contractual agreements with participants. It helps strengthen Idaho's healthcare workforce by protecting licensees while fulfilling program requirements and making Idaho safer for patients.
